Wellesley Station Second Exit and Automatic Entrance

Start Date: Fall 2014

End Date: Spring 2017

Work Description & Purpose

Over the next few months, work will begin on Dundonald Street to prepare for the new second exit and automatic entrance at Wellesley Station. Second exits enhance customer safety, providing an additional way out of subway stations in case of emergency. Similar to many TTC stations, Wellesley currently has only one exit. An automatic entrance will improve customer convenience.

Traffic and Parking Details

Dundonald Street will be closed to vehicular traffic in front of 15 Dundonald. During this time, east-west through traffic from Yonge and Church streets will be restricted. Parking will also be restricted on Dundonald Street to allow for local two-way traffic.

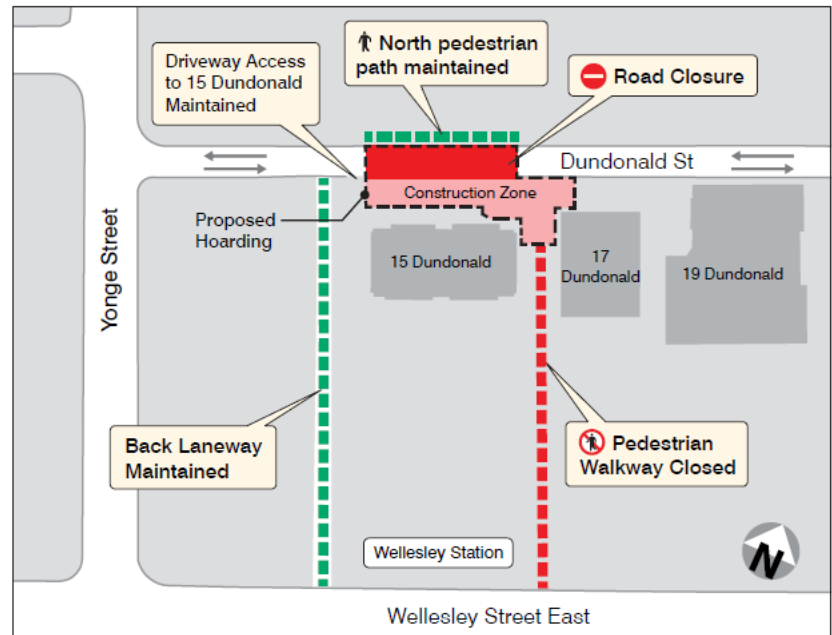
Pedestrian Details

A pedestrian path or detour will be maintained on the north side of Dundonald Street. The pedestrian walkway between Dundonald Street and Wellesley Street will be closed for the duration of the project. Pedestrians are asked to use Yonge and Church streets to access Wellesley Station.
